**Hole # 1:**

This is a demanding par four; a well-placed tee shot into the fairway is a must. Second shot is to an elevated green with a bunker front left and one on the right side.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 3 (men) / 11 (women)



**Hole # 2:**

This is the first of five very demanding par three's. If you are going to have a good score, playing the par three's in even par is a good start. This one plays up to 220 yards, slightly downhill.

**Par:** 3

**Handicap:** 17 (men) / 17 (women)



**Hole # 3:**

This is a par five and a very good birdy opportunity at 552 yards. A tee shot must be left of the right tree line, or you will be blocked out on the second shot.

**Par:** 5

**Handicap:** 7 (men) / 1 (women)



**Hole # 4:**

A slight cut off the tee with a driver or a well hit three wood is the play. Avoid the right woods, as they are out of bounds. A good tee ball will leave you with a short iron into a two level green.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 13 (men) / 13 (women)



**Hole # 5:**

The fifth hole is a 400 yard par 4. Split the bunkers with the tee shot. For long hitters, the right bunker is carryable, but will leave you in heavy rough.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 11 (men) / 9 (women)

**Hole # 6:**

Here, the perfect shot is a draw. Avoid the left fairway bunkers at all costs. The right oaks usually offer a play to advance the ball well down the fairway.

**Par:** 5

**Handicap:** 9 (men) / 3 (women)



**Hole # 7:**

Your tee shot is straight; however, avoid the right rough as the large pine trees on that side will block your second shot. The second shot into the green is a mid to short iron.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 5 (men) / 7 (women)

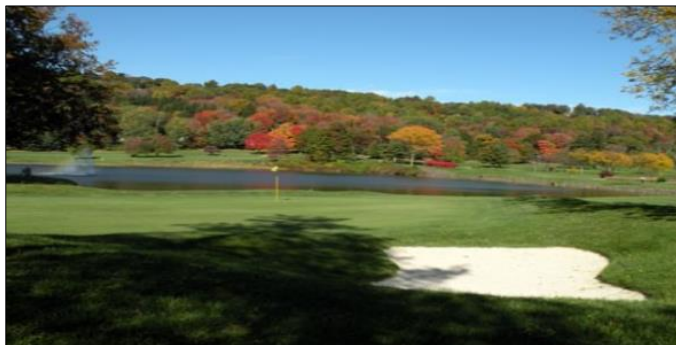


**Hole # 8:**

The tee shot from the left tree requires a draw to avoid the left bunker and right rough. The right tee shot is more straight away.

**Par:** 4 (men) / 5 (women)

**Handicap:** 1 (men) / 5 (women)



**Hole # 9:**

The ninth hole is the second of five par threes and the first of three in a row. This shot is over water to a green angled slightly away from the player. Watch the water to the right.

**Par:** 3

**Handicap:** 15 (men) / 15 (women)



**Hole # 10:**

This shot is over water. It plays very true to the yardage. Just watch out for the wind. The green has two levels: one left and one right, with a gradual slope in the middle.

**Par:** 3

**Handicap:** 16 (men) / 18 (women)

**Hole # 11:**

There are 3 bunkers, two left and a large, deep one to the right. If the pin is left, avoid missing left, as getting up and down is nearly impossible.

**Par:** 3

**Handicap:** 18 (men) / 14 (women)



**Hole # 12:**

This short par four is a good birdie hole. Club selection off the tee is important.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 10 (men) / 6 (women)



**Hole # 13:**

This 445 yard par 4 is possibly the best on the course. A long tee shot, favoring a draw, is a good play. The second shot is up hill to a very elevated green.

**Par:** 4 (men) / 5 (women)

**Handicap:** 2 (men) / 4 (women)



**Hole # 14:**

This is the fifth par 3 and certainly the most scenic. The green is guarded by three bunkers, two right and one left, as well as water down the left side.

**Par:** 3

**Handicap:** 14 (men) / 16 (women)



**Hole # 15:**

The fairway slopes right to left, so a slight cut off the tee is a good play as the ball will kick back to the left.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 8 (men) / 10 (women)

**Hole # 16:**

This is a 432 par 4 with a dogleg to the left and out-of-bounds right. The fairway bunkers are well placed, as the left one is very hard to carry and the right one is sure to catch a long straight drive.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 4 (men) / 8 (women)



**Hole # 17:**

The tee shot is very critical on this hole, with fairway bunkers left and right and water down the right side.

**Par:** 5

**Handicap:** 12 (men) / 2 (women)



**Hole # 18:**

This is a great par four. The fairway is a slight dogleg right, with out-of-bounds right. A fade off the tee is an ideal shot.

**Par:** 4

**Handicap:** 6 (men) / 12 (women)
